

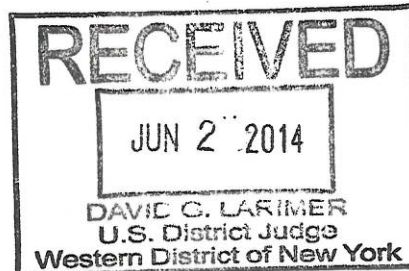

Dear Judge Larimer:

This SSA case was remanded under Sentence Six (42 U.S.C. § 405(g)) in September 2011.

The Commissioner has since issued a favorable determination of plaintiff's disability claim. A copy is annexed. I was not the attorney in the administrative proceedings and obtained it from Ms. James non-attorney representatives. The Clerk's office has told me that the last docket entry was the Court's above order.

Following discussions with the U.S. Attorney's office and chambers, I am writing here to request the Court to direct the Clerk's office to enter judgment, dismissing the complaint in light of the subsequent, favorable administrative determination. Judgment will then serve as a trigger to further action by the parties, be it appeal or application for attorney fees under EAJA.
