Currently pending before the Court is plaintiff's motion to compel the production of certain documents. <u>See</u> Motion to Compel (Docket # 28). The motion has been fully briefed and submitted to the Court. <u>See</u> Declaration (Docket # 27); Reply (Docket # 29). The Court is reviewing the submissions and will advise the parties if it determines that oral argument is needed. <u>See</u> Motion for a Hearing (Docket # 30); Order (Docket # 31).

The standing Scheduling Order calls for a close to discovery on April 29, 2016. <u>See</u> Amended Scheduling Order (Docket # 24). In pursuit of that deadline, counsel for the defense filed a notice to take plaintiff's deposition by video, scheduled for April 20, 2016. <u>See</u> Notice (Docket ## 32, 33). Plaintiff has asked by letter dated April 10, 2016, to postpone the deposition until his motion to compel has been decided. With no objection from the defense, it is **ORDERED** that the deposition of plaintiff shall be postponed until the Court rules on the motion to compel, and it is further

ORDERED that the current Scheduling Order is extended pending the Court's decision on the motion to compel. The Court will issue a new Scheduling Order upon entry of a decision.
