


4(m) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, an action shall be dismissed without prejudice against a defendant who has not been timely served unless plaintiff demonstrates good cause to the court why service was late. Plaintiff must comply with Rule 4(m) within 14 days of the entry of this order. See Fed. R. Civ. P. 4(m). Thereafter, the record will be forwarded to the presiding judge to whom this action is assigned for a determination of whether plaintiff demonstrated good cause. Failure to respond to this notice within the time allotted will result in dismissal of defendant Global International without prejudice.
