


Treasury Judgment Fund, in full satisfaction of any and all claims against the Defendant arising from the above captioned case under the EAJA, 28 U.S.C. § 2412(d), and upon the payment of such sum, the Defendant shall be discharged from any further liability for fees, costs or expenses up until this point in time; and it is further

ORDERED, that in accordance with Plaintiff's assignment of EAJA fees, if there is no debt that qualifies under the Treasury Offset Program, the award will be sent Plaintiff's Counsel's office address, Charlotte Hall, attorney. If there is such a debt, any amount remaining after offset will be made payable to Plaintiff and sent to Plaintiff's counsel.
