The current Plaintiff JO ALLISON STRICKLAND in her capacity as Next Friend for SARAH STRICKLAND, has moved pursuant to Rule 25 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure to have Sarah Strickland substituted into the case individually and directly as a party Plaintiff, in place of Jo Allison Strickland in her capacity as Next Friend, on the ground that Sarah Strickland has reached the age of majority during the pendency of this action.
