

ORDER

On June 22, 2016, the court adopted the Memorandum and Recommendation (“M&R”) [D.E. 21], overruled plaintiff’s objections to the M&R [D.E. 23], granted defendant’s motion for summary judgment [D.E. 13], affirmed defendant’s final decision, and dismissed the action.
