ORDER GRANTING CONSENT
MOTION TO STAY AND COMPELLING
ARBITRATION

This matter is before the Court on Defendants Shuckin Shack Franchising, LLC, Shuckin Shack Oyster Bar, Inc., Sean Cook, Matthew Piccinin and Jonathan Weathington's Motion to Stay and Compel Arbitration pursuant to the Federal Arbitration Act (9 U.S.C. §2, *et. seq.*).
