This action being submitted to the Court for an Order upon Plaintiff's showing that the Commissioner of Social Security should pay the sum of \$12,072.88 for attorney fees, representing less than 25% of Plaintiff's accrued back benefits, to be paid from Plaintiff's back benefits pursuant to § 406(b) of the Social Security Act. It also appearing that upon receipt of the 406(b) fee, Plaintiff's counsel shall pay to Plaintiff the lesser EAJA fee of \$3,750.00.

It is therefore ORDERED that the Commissioner of Social Security pay to Plaintiff's counsel, Charlotte W. Hall, the sum of \$12,072.88 and that Plaintiff's counsel pay to Plaintiff the sum of \$3,750.00 and upon the payment of such sums, this case is dismissed with prejudice.
