ORDER

BEATY, District Judge.

This matter is before the Court on a Recommendation [Doc. #4] of the United States Magistrate Judge recommending that this matter be dismissed *sua sponte* due to Plaintiff's failure to serve Defendant Gary RaShawn Scales within 120 days of filing her Complaint [Doc. #1]. The Recommendation was filed on March 20, 2015, and notice was served on the parties pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b). On March 30, 2015, Plaintiff filed a timely Objection to the Recommendation [Doc. #6].
