In their Answer to Plaintiff's Complaint, Defendants asserted Counterclaims and a Third Party Complaint. Accordingly, the Court **DENIES as moot** the Motion to Dismiss Counterclaims [# 14] and Motion to Strike Answer to Complaint [# 12].
