ORDER


THIS MATTER is before the Court on the Plaintiff’s Consent Motion for Relief from Judgment [Doc. 40].

In her motion, the Plaintiff states that this matter has been settled and that it is equitably in the best interest of the parties to allow relief from the Judgment.
