
**FOR THE REASONS** stated in the Memorandum of Decision and Order entered contemporaneously herewith,

**IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED** that the Defendant's Motion for Summary Judgment is **DENIED**, and the Plaintiff's Motion for Judgment on the Pleadings [Doc. 11] is **GRANTED** to the extent that the Plaintiff seeks reversal of the Commissioner's decision denying her disability benefits. To the extent that the Plaintiff seeks an immediate award of benefits, the Plaintiff's Motion [Doc. 11] is **DENIED**.

Pursuant to the power of this Court to enter a judgment affirming, modifying or reversing the decision of the Commissioner under Sentence Four of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g), the decision of the Commissioner is

**REVERSED** and this case is hereby **REMANDED** for further administrative proceedings consistent with this opinion.
