
THIS MATTER IS BEFORE THE COURT sua sponte upon Defendant Amanda Stone's "Motion To Dismiss" (document #6).

The Court also advises Plaintiff that failure to respond may result in Defendant being granted the relief she seeks, that is, the **DISMISSAL OF THE COMPLAINT WITH PREJUDICE**.
