Pending before the Court is the Consent Motion to Stay [# 20]. Previously, the Court stayed these proceedings. The Government now moves to continue the stay pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 981(g)(1) for a period of 90 days. Claimants consent to staying these proceedings for the additional time period.
