THIS MATTER is before the Court sua sponte.

On May 10, 2018, after receiving an extension of time to do so, Defendants United States of America, United States Postal Service, and Leslie Ann Shaffer filed an Answer to the Plaintiff's Complaint. Plaintiff is advised that failure to take further action against this

Defendant will result in the dismissal of the Plaintiff's claims against

him.
