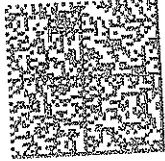

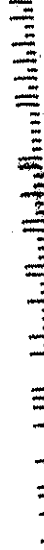

Dear Ms. Mendes:

On 2 February 2010, the office of the Information and Privacy Coordinator received your 25 January 2010 Freedom of Information Act request for information or records on **Joseph Patrick Kennedy, Jr. (deceased); Payton H. Courtney (deceased); and your father, Roberto G. Sanchez.** Your request has been assigned the reference number above; please use this number when corresponding about this request.


We need as much identifying information as possible before we can effectively search our files for information on individual. Please provide us with the full name, date and place of birth, and citizenship status of each of the individuals listed above. With regard to searches on your father, you state in your letter that he was born in Tampico, Mexico. If Mr. Sanchez is a legal permanent resident (LPR) or a naturalized U.S. citizen, we must ask you to provide the LPR or naturalization number and date he acquired that status. Without this data, we may be unable to distinguish between individuals with the same or similar names. For individuals who are deceased, please provide some evidence of death, such as a death certificate, an obituary, or press statement.

Agency regulations encourage requesters seeking information on third parties to provide a signed affidavit or declaration from the third parties waiving all or some of their privacy rights. We can search without this authorization, but if we locate responsive records, privacy concerns may require us to protect the information from release.

FOIA exemption (b)(6), a copy of which I have enclosed for your reference and retention, requires us to protect information "the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy." In reaching this determination, we use the test our enclosed regulations outline at 32 CFR § 1900.32(b): "the Agency will balance the privacy interests that would be compromised by disclosure against the public interest in release of the requested information." Therefore the waiver will assist us with this determination.

We will hold your request in suspense for 45 days from the date of this letter, pending receipt of the required full biographic information on each individual, to include the date and place of birth and citizenship and proof of death or privacy waiver, as appropriate.

## Explanation of Exemptions

### Freedom of Information Act:

- (b)(1) exempts from disclosure information currently and properly classified, pursuant to an Executive Order;
- (b)(2) exempts from disclosure information, which pertains solely to the internal personnel rules and practices of the Agency;
- (b)(3) exempts from disclosure information that another federal statute protects, provided that the other federal statute either requires that the matters be withheld, or establishes particular criteria for withholding or refers to particular types of matters to be withheld. The (b)(3) statutes upon which the CIA relies include, but are not limited to, the CIA Act of 1949;
- (b)(4) exempts from disclosure trade secrets and commercial or financial information that is obtained from a person and that is privileged or confidential;
- (b)(5) exempts from disclosure inter-and intra-agency memoranda or letters that would not be available by law to a party other than an agency in litigation with the agency;
- (b)(6) exempts from disclosure information from personnel and medical files and similar files the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of privacy;
- (b)(7) exempts from disclosure information compiled for law enforcement purposes to the extent that the production of the information (A) could reasonably be expected to interfere with enforcement proceedings; (B) would deprive a person of a right to a fair trial or an impartial adjudication; (C) could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy; (D) could reasonably be expected to disclose the identity of a confidential source or, in the case of information compiled by a criminal law enforcement authority in the course of a criminal investigation or by an agency conducting a lawful national security intelligence investigation, information furnished by a confidential source; (E) would disclose techniques and procedures for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions if such disclosure could reasonably be expected to risk circumvention of the law; or (F) could reasonably be expected to endanger any individual's life or physical safety;
- (b)(8) exempts from disclosure information contained in reports or related to examination, operating, or condition reports prepared by, or on behalf of, or for use of an agency responsible for regulating or supervising financial institutions; and
- (b)(9) exempts from disclosure geological and geophysical information and data, including maps, concerning wells.

**§ 1900. 32 Procedures for information  
concerning other persons.**

(a) *In general.* Personal information concerning individuals other than the requester shall not be disclosed under the Freedom of Information Act if the proposed release would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. See 5 U.S.C. 552(b)(6). For purposes of this section, the following definitions apply:

(1) *personal information* means any information about an individual that is not a matter of public record, or easily discernible to the public, or protected from disclosure because of the implications that arise from Government possession of such information.

(2) *public interest* means the public interest in understanding the operations and activities of the United States Government and not simply any matter which might be of general interest to the requester or members of the public.

(b) *Determination to be made.* In making the required determination under this section and pursuant to exemption (b)(6) of the FOIA, the Agency will balance the privacy interests that would be compromised by disclosure against the public interest in release of the requested information.

(c) *Otherwise.* A requester seeking information on a third person is encouraged to provide a signed affidavit or declaration from the third person waiving all or some of their privacy rights. However, all such waivers shall be narrowly construed and the Coordinator, in the exercise of his discretion and administrative authority, may seek clarification from the third party prior to any or all releases.
