

Therefore, the Court ordered Petitioner to do so and to inform the Court whether he wished to prosecute this action within thirty days of the Court’s Order. (Doc. No. 3). The Court warned Petitioner that his failure to obey the Court’s Order would result in the dismissal of his petition. (*Id.*). The Court requested that Lynn Summers, Jr., administrator of Hoke Correctional Institution, forward this Order to Petitioner or to the North Carolina Parole Commission for forwarding to Petitioner.

Petitioner has failed to respond to the Court’s Order.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that:

1. Petitioner’s Petition under 28 U.S.C. § 2254 for Writ of Habeas Corpus, (Doc. No. 1), is **DISMISSED**.
