**THIS MATTER** is before the Court on “Bank of America’s Motion to Stay Pending the Covered Business Method Review of the Asserted Patents by the United States Patent and Trademark Office” (document #51) filed November 13, 2013. **THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED** that:


