
ORDER CONSOLIDATING CASES

THIS MATTER comes before the Court on a joint Motion to Consolidate filed in CCR Data Systems, Inc. et al., v. Community One Bank, N.A., Case No. 3:16-cv-63-RJC-DSC. (Doc. No. 2). In the Motion, the parties move, pursuant to Rule 42(a) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, to consolidate Yale, et al., v. Community One Bank, N.A., Case No. 3:15-cv-403-RJC-DSC, with CCR Data Systems, Inc. et al., v. Community One Bank, N.A., Case No. 3:16-cv-63-RJC-DSC, for purposes of pretrial motions, discovery, and trial. For good cause shown, this Motion is **granted**.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that this action is consolidated into Yale, et al., v.

Community One Bank, N.A., Case No. 3:15-cv-403-RJC-DSC, and that all future filings shall utilize the case number 3:15-cv-403-RJC-DSC. Furthermore, to avoid duplicative motions, responses, and briefs, Community One Bank's pending motion to dismiss in Case No. 3:15-cv-403-RJC-DSC, (Doc. No. 9), and the plaintiffs' resistance to that motion, including the briefs submitted by the parties, shall apply and be treated as if also filed in Case No. 3:16-cv-63-RJC-DSC, such that the Court's ruling on the motion to dismiss shall apply to and control in both cases.
