THIS MATTER IS BEFORE THE COURT on the Plaintiff's Petition for Attorney's Fees Under the Equal Access to Justice Act (the "Motion"). [Doc. No. 17]. In the Motion, the Plaintiff requests attorney's fees in the amount of \$5,000.00, representing 27.8 hours of attorney work.
