THIS MATTER is before the Court on its own motion on the Government's Response to Order to Show Cause [Doc. 7] and the United States Supreme Court's decision in <u>United States v.</u> Davis, No. 18-431.

Petitioner's Section 2255 Motion to Vacate Sentence [Doc. 1] has been stayed since August 16, 2016, pending the decision of the Fourth Circuit Court of Appeals in <u>United States v. Ali</u>, No. 15-4433. The Fourth Circuit stayed <u>Ali</u> pending the Supreme Court's decision in <u>United States v. Davis</u>, No. 18-431. On June 24, 2019, the Supreme Court decided <u>Davis</u>. On September 4, 2019, the Court ordered the parties to show cause as to why the stay should not be lifted in light of <u>Davis</u>. On September 10, 2019, the Government filed a response indicating that it and Petitioner agreed the stay should be lifted. [Doc. 7].

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that the stay in this matter is hereby **LIFTED** and the Government shall have until October 10, 2019, to file its response in this matter.
