ORDER

THIS MATTER IS BEFORE THE COURT on “Plaintiff’s Motion To Stay Filing Of Certificate Of Initial Attorney’s Conference And Joint Rule 26(f) Report” (Document No. 6) filed June 7, 2017. This motion has been referred to the undersigned Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b), and immediate review is appropriate. Having carefully considered the motion, the record, and noting consent of Defendant’s counsel, the undersigned will grant the motion.
