
This matter was referred to the undersigned Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636, and this Motion is now ripe for consideration.

The Court concludes that Plaintiff’s claims “are so related to claims in the action within such original jurisdiction that they form part of the same case or controversy under Article III of the United States Constitution.” 28 U.S.C. § 1367(a). Plaintiff has not demonstrated compelling reasons for declining supplemental jurisdiction here. For those and the other reasons set forth in Defendants Leon and Percy’s “Response ...” (document #11), the Motion will be denied.
