



The Judicial Conference, in turn, has provided for the collection of a filing fee “[f]or filing an appeal or cross appeal from a judgment, order, or decree, [of] \$293. This fee is collected in addition to the statutory fee of \$5 that is collected under 28 U.S.C. § 1930(c) when a notice of appeal is filed.” Bankruptcy Court Miscellaneous Fee Schedule (Dec. 1, 2016).<sup>1</sup>


Finally, the court has considered whether further notice is likely to gain compliance. Appellant was provided notice of deficiency on June 30, 2017, and again provided notice when a copy of the Memorandum was mailed to appellant on July 12, 2017. Appellant has in no manner sought to cure the deficiency or in any manner communicate with the Court.

**IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED** that this appeal is **DISMISSED**.
