



- a. Treating physicians need not prepare reports, only qualifications, unless they will express opinions not reflected in the medical records.
  - b. Report to be served on other parties, but not filed with the court.
  - c. Plaintiff shall have until March 15, 2015, and Defendant shall have until April 15, 2015, to identify the subject matter/discipline of expert witnesses.
  - d. Plaintiff shall have until April 15, 2015, and Defendant shall have until May 15, 2015, to provide the names of expert witnesses and complete reports under Rule 26(a)(2).
3. The parties shall have until June 15, 2015 to complete discovery depositions of expert witnesses.
  4. The parties shall have until May 15, 2015 to file other nondispositive motions (e.g., consolidation, bifurcation).
  5. The parties shall have until August 14, 2015 to file other dispositive motions (summary judgment as to all or part of the case).

In addition, the final pretrial conference is reset for December 30, 2015 at 1:30 PM by telephone before Magistrate Judge Miller. The court will initiate the conference call. The jury trial is reset for January 11, 2016 at 9:30 AM in Bismarck Courtroom 1 before Judge Hovland. The trial will be set for five (5) days.
