On May 1, 2017, Plaintiffs Target Logistics Management, LLC, and Williston Lodging Solutions - Williston LLC, and Defendant City of Williston filed a “Stipulation for Stay and Termination of Deadlines.” They request that the court suspend all pretrial deadlines and stay the above-entitled action for a period of six months.
