Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636, the court has received a Report and Recommendation from the Honorable Alice R. Senechal, United States Magistrate Judge. The Report and Recommendation recommends that Moore's habeas petition be dismissed without prejudice for lack of jurisdiction. Moore filed an objection after the deadline for submitting objections expired.² In his objection, he contends the magistrate judge misapplied the law because there is no requirement that he seek leave to file a second habeas corpus petition. He also states that he did not receive the Report and Recommendation until March 2, 2017.

The court has considered Moore's objections and the record. After reviewing the magistrate judge's Report and Recommendation, the record, and Moore's objections, the court finds the magistrate judge's analysis and recommendation for disposition is appropriate. Accordingly, the court hereby adopts the Report and Recommendation in its entirety.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Moore's petition be dismissed without prejudice for lack of jurisdiction because it is a second or successive petition challenging his state
