the time Plaintiff spent on the litigation.<sup>6/</sup>

Plaintiff's counsel will receive \$ 35,299.65 for services rendered.<sup>7/</sup> This award of attorney's fees is reasonable in light of the hours and skill expended on litigation and settlement.<sup>8/</sup>

The notice to be sent to each member of the collective is detailed, clear, and informative.<sup>9/</sup> The parties reasonably seek to avoid the expense and burden of litigating this bona fide dispute and the terms of the agreement reflect fair bargaining.

Accordingly, the Court **APPROVES** the proposed settlement agreement as fair and reasonable, **APPROVES** the proposed notice to the collective, and **DISMISSES** this case with prejudice. Each party will bear its own attorney's fees and costs except as provided in the settlement agreement, and the Court retains jurisdiction to enforce the proposed settlement agreement. Plaintiff's counsel shall immediately inform the Court if any member of the collective opts out of the settlement agreement.
