recommendation.<sup>5/</sup> Absent objection, a district court may adopt the Magistrate Judge's report without review.<sup>6/</sup> Moreover, having conducted its own review of the complaint<sup>7/</sup> and briefing,<sup>8/</sup> this Court agrees with the conclusions of the Magistrate Judge.

Accordingly, the Court **ADOPTS** in whole Magistrate Judge Armstrong's findings of fact and conclusions of law and incorporates them fully herein by reference. The Court **AFFIRMS** the Commissioner's denial of supplemental security income.
