JAMES S. GWIN, UNITED STATES DISTRICT JUDGE:

Defendant-Cross Claimant Anthony Viola moves for default judgment under [Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 55](#) against Defendants-Cross Defendants Chase Bank USA, N.A. (“Chase Bank”) and Citibank (South Dakota) (“Citibank”) for failure to plead or otherwise defend.¹ On January 13, 2017, the Court dismissed the case as to Defendants Citibank and Chase Bank for want of prosecution by Plaintiff U.S. Bank National Association.² Because Citibank and Chase Bank are no longer parties to the case, Viola’s motion for default judgment is moot. Accordingly, the Court **DENIES** Defendant-Cross Claimant Viola’s motion for default judgment.
