Plaintiffs' objection.⁵ Finally, Mattice's declaration sufficiently details Mattice's opinions and his rationale.⁶

Additionally, Plaintiffs say Tristar gave them notice of Mattice's report one day late.⁷ Defendant filed Mattice's report three weeks before the deadline.⁸ This gave Plaintiffs sufficient notice and access to the report.

Therefore, the Court **DENIES** Plaintiffs' objection to Tristar's expert Jason M. Mattice's report and **CANCELS** the March 29, 2017 hearing.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
