OPINION & ORDER [Resolving Docs. <u>1</u>, <u>16</u>]

## JAMES S. GWIN, UNITED STATES DISTRICT JUDGE:

On October 4, 2016, Plaintiff Tyisha Barber, on behalf of her minor daughter, D.A., sued to reverse a supplemental security income denial.<sup>1</sup> On July 28, 2017, Magistrate Judge Jonathan D. Greenberg recommended vacating and remanding the Commissioner's denial of benefits.<sup>2</sup> On August 9, 2017, the Defendant Commissioner notified the Court that it would not file objections to the Magistrate Judge's recommendation.<sup>3</sup>

The Federal Magistrates Act requires a district court to conduct a de novo review only of those portions of a Report and Recommendation to which the parties have made an objection.<sup>4</sup> Failure to timely object waives a party's right to appeal the magistrate's report. <sup>5</sup>

Absent objection, a district court may adopt the magistrate judge's report without review.<sup>6</sup> Moreover, having conducted its own review of the complaint and record, the Court agrees with the conclusions in the Report and Recommendation.
