On November 21, 2016, *pro se* Plaintiff Brian Keith Ford filed a Complaint against the Commissioner of Social Security. The Court referred the case to Magistrate Judge James R. Knepp II for preparation of a report and recommendation pursuant to [28 U.S.C. § 636](#) and [Local Rule 72.2\(b\)\(1\)](#). On June 23, 2017, the magistrate judge submitted a Report ([ECF No. 13](#)) recommending that this case be dismissed for want of prosecution.

[Fed. R. Civ. P. 72\(b\)\(2\)](#) provides that objections to a Report and Recommendation must be filed within 14 days after service. Objections to the magistrate judge's Report and Recommendation were, therefore, due on July 10, 2017.<sup>1</sup> Neither party has filed objections, evidencing satisfaction with the magistrate judge's recommendation. Any further review by this

<sup>1</sup> Objections to the Report were due on July 7, 2017. See [ECF No. 13 at PageID #: 1388](#). Because *pro se* Plaintiff Brian Keith Ford was served with the Report by mail pursuant to [Fed. R. Civ. P. 5\(b\)\(2\)\(C\)](#), he was allowed an additional three (3) days to file an Objection. See [Fed. R. Civ. P. 6\(d\)](#).

Court would be a duplicative and inefficient use of the Court's limited resources. *Thomas v. Arn*, 728 F.2d 813 (6th Cir. 1984), *aff'd*, 474 U.S. 140 (1985); *Howard v. Secretary of Health and Human Services*, 932 F.2d 505 (6th Cir. 1991); *United States v. Walters*, 638 F.2d 947, 949-50 (6th Cir. 1981).

Accordingly, the Report and Recommendation of the magistrate judge is hereby adopted.

This case is dismissed without prejudice.
