On August 29, 2019, the Court held Plaintiffs' motion for judgment on their indemnification claim in abeyance pending the Ohio Supreme Court's resolution of *Ayers v. City of Cleveland.*¹ The Court instructed that Plaintiffs could renew their argument once *Ayers* is decided. Accordingly, there has been no final judgment in this case.

Because there has been no final judgment, the Court hereby denies three of Defendants' motions as premature. *See* Doc. <u>364</u> (motion to stay execution of judgment); Doc. <u>385</u> (motion to stay debt collection proceedings); Doc. <u>387</u> (motion to waive bond). Defendants may renew these motions once the court renders final judgment in this case.
