On April 26, 2018, Plaintiff International Union of Operating Engineers filed a first amended complaint challenging an arbitration award.¹ Because Plaintiff filed an amended complaint 21 days after Defendant Ohio Contractors Association filed its motion to dismiss, Plaintiff did not require the Court's permission to amend.² Accordingly, Defendant's motion to dismiss Plaintiff's original complaint is now moot.³

The Court therefore **DENIES AS MOOT** Defendant's motion to dismiss. Furthermore, the Court will determine a scheduling order for briefing on the merits at the Case Management Conference.
