MOTION:

Plaintiff Mark Anders Tronsen respectfully moves and requests that this Honorable court review the prior case of Tronsen v. Toledo – Lucas County Library et al. , number CI 02006 - 01131 with a view towards determining whether or not the court(s) of Lucas County did a legally adequate job or protecting his First Amendment rights in that previous, somewhat similar matter.

Plaintiff says and alleges:

- a) The purpose of 42.1983 protection(s) is to not only protect the exercise of First Amendment rights by visiting sanctions-consequences to those who have violated them, but also to discourage future losses-abuses of those precious freedoms the founders of this nation envisioned and fought for; in many cases sacrificed their lives & property for; they codified the very protections Plaintiff invokes in his pleadings
- b) That the previous court did not legally, adequately protect Plaintiffs rights by punishing the defendants in the previous matter.
