Narrative Report of Research, Teaching, and Clinical Contributions

My research revolves primarily around four major studies. One is the Nurses' Health Study, a cohort of 121,700 nurses followed since 1976 with biennial questionnaires. Endpoints of interest include cancer, cardiovascular diseases, fractures, diabetes, and other major health problems. I am a co-investigator on two other cohort studies that have the same design. One is the Nurses' Health Study II, a study of 116,680 nurses aged 25-42 in 1989 when the study began; the other is the Health Professionals Follow-Up Study, a cohort of 51,000 men begun in 1986. My grant to study the causes of kidney stones is based in these three cohorts. I am also Principal Investigator of two grants to analyze blood samples collected as part of the Physicians' Health Study Trial of Aspirin and Beta-Carotene; 14,900 blood samples have been stored at -80C since 1982. Using a nested case-control design, the samples are analyzed for a variety of markers of cancer and heart disease risk.

Although a wide range of topics are examined in these studies, the major focus is on nutrition. These large cohorts require considerable attention to develop and refine nutritional methods, and make use of a wide array of techniques to evaluate dietary intake. These include food frequency questionnaires, diet records, anthropometry, and biochemical analyses of serum, plasma, red cells, adipose tissue and toenails. These studies investigate a broad range of health outcomes including cancer, cardiovascular disease and their precursors such as polyps, benign breast disease, hypertension, high cholesterol, diabetes, and obesity.

I have no clinical contributions. Most of my teaching is at the Harvard School of Public Health, where I direct a course on Scientific Writing in Nutritional Epidemiology and co-direct the Practice of Epidemiology; I serve as chair of the Department of Epidemiology. In addition, I contribute guest lectures in other courses. I advise several

doctoral students and postdoctoral fellows, and devote considerable energy to helping junior faculty. At Harvard Medical School, I assist in the advanced epidemiology course and give lectures in the preventive medicine course.

Report of Current Research Activities

My research revolves around four major studies: the Nurses' Health Study, Nurses' Health Study II, Health Professionals' Follow-up Study, and the Physicians' Health Study. The major theme of most of my work has been nutrition and chronic disease. Under this broad umbrella, I am studying a wide variety of exposures and disease outcomes. Some of the data are derived from questionnaires, but much comes from biological samples. These include biomarkers in relation to risk of stroke, coronary heart disease, and cancers of the colon, lung, and prostate using blood samples collected as part of the Physicians' Health Study, the Health Professionals' Follow-up Study, and the Nurses' Health Study. Another area of interest is nutrition and prostate cancer, both for etiology and prognosis.
