On July 15, 2010, petitioner <u>pro se</u> Dante Morris, a prisoner at FPI Fort Dix, filed this Motion to Vacate, Set Aside, or Correct Sentence by a Person in Federal Custody under 28 U.S.C. § 2255, seeking to challenge his January 2010 conviction in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania.
