ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT

This matter is before the Court for consideration of Respondent's Application for

Reinstatement. Respondent avers that, on July 21, 2006, the Supreme Court of Ohio reinstated

finds that Mr. Greco is fit to resume and is hereby permitted to practice law before this Court.
