ORDER granting 50 Motion for Order in Support of Remand in order to Dismiss State Law Claims. Plaintiff seeks to dismiss the state law false arrest, malicious prosecution, and state law assault and battery claims against Defendants Watson and Shepard. An appeal based on immunity claims under O.R.C. Section 2744 is pending in the Sixth Circuit with respect to those claims. Pursuant to the procedure outlined in First National bank of Salem, Ohio v. Hirsch, 535 F.2d 343 (6th Cir. 1976), this Court hereby expresses its willingness to grant a motion to dismiss the state law false arrest, malicious prosecution and state law assault and battery claims against Defendants Watson and Shepard upon remand of these claims to the District Court.
