- 1. All claims against Defendants Mark Davis, Vicki Barker, Gregg Harrison, Terri Boggs-Blakeman, and Julie Boehle are **DISMISSED with prejudice** pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e); and
- 2. Plaintiff's employment discrimination claims are permitted to proceed solely against his former employer, identified variously in the complaint and accompanying exhibits as Atos Technical Solution, and/or ATOS IT Solutions and Services, Inc.
