

¹ After reviewing the Report and Recommendation, Petitioner’s objections, and the case record, the Court finds that Petitioner’s objections are not well taken. Plaintiff’s objections argue the merits of the ALJ’s determination by outlining the difficulties Plaintiff’s daughter faces in her daily life. Plaintiff’s perspective, while valuable to the Court, restates the arguments raised in Plaintiff’s statement of specific errors (Doc. 11) and does not address the Magistrate Judge’s findings indicating that the ALJ’s decision was supported by substantial evidence in the medical record. Accordingly, the Report and Recommendation is adopted in its entirety.
