DECISION AND ENTRY ADOPTING THE REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION OF THE UNITED STATES MAGISTRATE JUDGE (Doc. 2)

This case is before the Court pursuant to the Order of General Reference in the United States District Court for the Southern District of Ohio Western Division to United States Magistrate Judge Karen L. determine that such Report and Recommendation should be and is hereby adopted in its

- Plaintiff's complaint is **DISMISSED AS DUPLICATIVE** under 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(2)(B)
- 2) The Court certifies that pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a)(3), an appeal of this Order would not be taken in good faith and therefore Plaintiff is denied leave to appeal *in forma pauperis*.
- 3) The Clerk shall enter judgment accordingly, whereupon this case shall be **CLOSED.**
