ORDER

Plaintiff, a state prisoner, has filed a notice of appeal concerning the dismissal of his case and has paid the full appellate filing fee. Notwithstanding the payment of the fee, the Court may still be required to certify whether the appeal is taken in good faith or not. <u>See McGore V. Wrigglesworth</u>, 114 F.3d 601, 611 (6th Cir. 1997); 28 U.S.C. §§1915(a)(3), (b)(1). The Court believes that colorable arguments in support of plaintiff's position can be advanced on appeal, and the Court therefore **DECLINES** to certify that the appeal is not taken in good faith.
