## ORDER

During today's telephonic status conference, the Parties indicated to the Court that they have made progress in completing the electronic file review contemplated by Paragraph 2 of the Court's Order of August 10, 2010. Counsel for Plaintiffs represented that they have completed the process of reviewing the more than 30,000 electronic files at issue and classified them into various categories based on their assessment of whether the files are subject to execution and sale, or are otherwise privileged or irrelevant.

Within thirty (30) days, Counsel for Plaintiffs shall file a brief with the Court describing the classification system used for the files and Counsels' basis for concluding whether each particular category is subject to execution and sale. Within thirty (30) days of service of

Plaintiffs' brief, Defendants may respond focusing on issues of whether particular categories are subject to execution and potential defenses and privileges applicable to particular categories of files. Plaintiffs may reply within ten (10) days of service of Defendants' response. Because the

briefing may implicate the privacy interests of third parties, all briefing shall be filed under seal.
