| February 11, 2011 | Final pretrial conference <b>rescheduled to begin at 2:30 p.m.</b> , submission of proposed areas of questions for voir dire and trial briefs.  |
| February 24, 2011 | Trial - voir dire, opening statements and presentation of evidence.   |
