## FINAL ORDER

Pursuant to the Court's previous Entries in the above-captioned matter, the Claims Distributor has filed his Final Report regarding the status of the distribution of the Distribution Fund. After review, the Court determines that the Claims Distributor has diligently sought to locate and inform the shareholders of Worthington Foods regarding the distribution of funds paid into the Court to be distributed to those shareholders who were affected by the defendants who purchased shares using inside information.

The Court agrees that the Claims Distributor has utilized all reasonable methods of locating the shareholders and distributing the Distribution Funds. The Court also concurs that the additional costs to do additional skip-tracing to find additional shareholders would be impractical.

The Court has determined that any claims of those shareholders who the Claims Distributor has been unable to locate are hereby denied.


Therefore, this Court hereby authorizes the Claims Distributor to distribute the remaining Distribution Fund as follows:

The Claims Distributor shall be reimbursed his fees and expenses in the amount of \$ 39,195.09.

The Claims Distributor shall reimburse the expenses and fees to the Accountant in an amount not to exceed \$9,600.00 upon receipt of the final accounting which shall be filed not later than May 31, 2010.

All remaining Funds in the Distribution Fund shall be paid to the Securities and Exchange Commission which shall be reimbursed for its expenses and shall cause the remaining funds to be paid to the U. S. Treasury.
