**ORDER**

On October 6, 2010, the Magistrate Judge issued an order for Plaintiff Jason Ellis to show cause why he should not be dismissed as a plaintiff from this litigation on the grounds that the relief he requests – certain prison religious accommodations – is moot. The Clerk of Court had received a returned copy of an order with notice that Ellis had been released from prison.

Plaintiff Jason Ellis has made no response to this order. Furthermore, the Clerk again, on December 2, 2010, received returned mail stating that Ellis had been released on September 13, 2010.

Accordingly, Plaintiff Jason Ellis is **DISMISSED** as a plaintiff in this action, as the relief requested in the complaint is now, with respect to him, moot.
