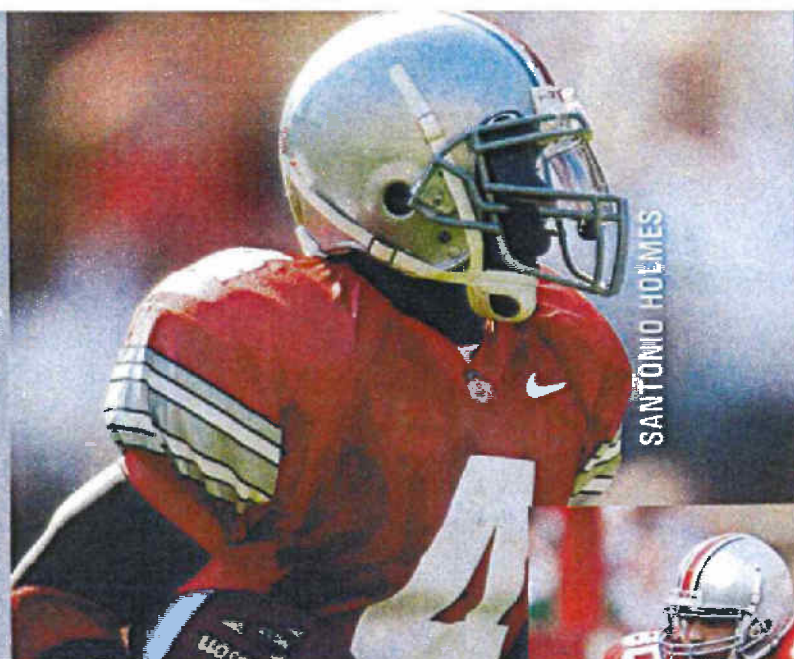
Buckeye Points of Pride

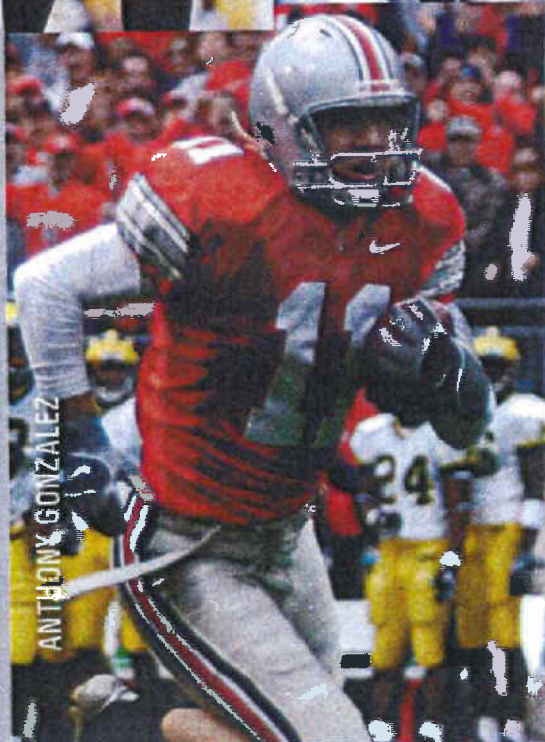
