ORDER

This matter came before the Court for a conference pursuant to S.D. Ohio Civ. R. 65.1 to discuss scheduling for the resolution of Plaintiff's Motion Under the Hague Convention for Entry of an Immediate Temporary Restraining Order and Scheduling of an Expedited Hearing, doc. 3, on October 17, 2013. As discussed at the conference, the Court directs the following:

- The Court will hold a hearing in this matter, the date and time of which will be established by separate notice of the Court;
- Defendant, Marsha Prince, and her minor children, B.U. and A.U., shall remain within the Southern District of Ohio until this case can be heard;
- In the event the need arises between the date of this Order and the date of the hearing on this matter, Ms. Prince may petition the Court for permission to leave the Southern District of Ohio;
- No bond is required given that the Plaintiff's motion is for a status quo injunction;
- This Order shall be in effect for fourteen days.
